

Northpower operates and maintains both the electricity distribution and fibre networks in the Whangarei and Kaipara region with more than 60,000 connected customers.





In addition to our engineering career opportunities, we hire a number of electricity trade trainees throughout the North Island in a variety of different roles. The most common trainee roles we recruit for are line mechanics, cable jointers and electrical fitters.

FAQ – The role of an electrical engineer

1. In a typical day, what do you do?

 - I work as a Design Estimator at Northpower's Auckland depot. My main responsibility is to prepare design and pricing solutions for the Underground distribution network be it replacement of HV switchgear, transformer or cabling. A typical day in my role entails getting out in the field to understand project scope/requirements, procuring materials, preparing and submitting detailed pricing summaries to the client. When not pricing, I assist the project manager in creating and updating project schedules, handling of technical queries from the client and monthly project billing.
2. I don't have a background in electrical engineering, can I still apply for the role? / What are the pre-requisites for the role?

 - We're ideally looking for current electrical engineering students to fulfil our internships and degree holders for our graduate vacancies. Our cadetships are more suitable for those who haven't already commenced study or chosen a specialisation.
3. What kind of skills are you looking for in a candidate?

 - Candidates need to have the specified educational requirements for the particular role they are applying for. Beyond that, we're looking for people who can show us they can take initiative and work as part of a team.
4. How do I apply for a role?

 - You can apply for any job you might see advertised on our website by submitting your CV and completing our application form. If you can't see any positions that match your requirements right now, you can sign up to our Careers website for notifications of new roles.

5. What's the hiring process like?
 - Our Recruitment team will review your CV against others received for a vacancy. You'll be notified if you're to be invited for an interview or if you're unsuccessful. If you're successful in your interview, you may be required to undertake some pre-employment checks and from there we'll advise you of the outcome of your application.
6. What would I be doing as an intern?
 - Our interns typically partner with other staff who introduce them to different aspects of our electricity network through observation and practical learning. You will be able to put your knowledge into practise and assist with projects.
7. I am a final year student and interested in a full time role. Do you also offer full time graduate engineer roles?
 - Most years we offer this opportunity. Please sign up to our careers website to be notified of any openings.
8. What is the difference between Northpower and Northpower contracting?
 - Northpower is comprised of our Northland electricity network operations and our corporate support functions. Our Contracting division perform services for other electricity networks around New Zealand
