

No Interest Tree Declaration

You can use this document to declare to Northpower that you have no interest in a tree/s on your land in accordance with regulations 15 and 16 of the Electricity (Hazards from Trees) Regulations 2003 (**Regulations**) and to request that Northpower trims or removes the tree/s.

A no interest letter will be accepted if the trees were naturally self-sown or if at the time of planting the owner could have reasonably believed the trees would not interfere with the power lines. A no interest letter will not be accepted for trees that were planted, where it would not have been reasonable to believe the tree would not interfere with the power lines.

Northpower will consider this declaration and let you know if it is accepted or declined.
